

GRADE 9 STUDENTS - OPTION SELECTION INFORMATION

****This year you begin to choose your pathway (college, university or workplace destination).**

Pathway Options within Course Code

- D indicates Academic Pathway (leads to university)
- P indicates Applied Pathway (leads to college)
- L indicates Locally Developed Pathway (leads to the workplace)

You must choose a full program of **8 courses** including five (**5**) **compulsory** and three (**3**) **electives**. If you were unsuccessful in one of your Grade 9 classes, you **must CHOOSE** that as an option **even if** you are planning to take it in night school or summer school.

❖ **You must choose five (5) Compulsory courses, one of each subject in the following chart:**

*** ADM 3M/4M- Drama in the Community & AMR/4M –Concert Band**

These courses run after school and at lunch time (a minimum of three times per week. They will be considered extra credits; therefore, you will choose **9 or 10 courses in total** on your option selection sheet.

*** NEW* ALLIANCE ACADEMY**

All students (all genders) are eligible to register for the Alliance Academy in the following focused areas:

Basketball: Offered Semester 1, housed at White Pines C. & V. S. (**course code FTE_BB**)

Hockey: Offered Semester 1, housed at the John Rhodes (**course code FTE_HS**)

Football: Offered Semester 2, housed at Superior Heights C. & V. S. (**course code FTE_FB**)

Soccer: Offered in Semester 2, housed at Korah C.& V.S. and the NCC (**course code FTE_SC**)

The Alliance Academy runs Period 1 and 2 and a shuttle bus will transport students to their home school for afternoon classes where applicable.
